Institute of Christ the King Sovereign Priest Code of Conduct Report Form - Connecticut

Connecticut law asks ALL individuals and REQUIRES Mandatory Reporters to report known or suspected child abuse or neglect, by telephone call within 12 hours of when obtaining information concerning child abuse or neglect, at the Hotline, which operates 24 hours per day, 365 days per year:

The mandatory reporter must file a written report within 48 hours of obtaining information of child abuse. For information on *who* is a Mandatory Reporter and *what* is considered known or suspected child abuse, see CT form DCF-136, https://portal.ct.gov/DCF/1-DCF/Reporting-Child-Abuse-and-Neglect.

Furthermore, the Archdiocese of Harford requires all Institute members, staff and volunteers to report any instances of sexual misconduct involving a minor or vulnerable adult and/or any instances where there is reasonable cause to suspect or believe that such sexual misconduct has occurred to the Victim Assistance Coordinator of the Archdiocese, whose contact information can be found here: https://promise.archdioceseofhartford.org/office-of-safe-environment/.

In addition, the Institute's Code of Conduct requires *all* members, staff and volunteers to report *all* behaviors that raise concerns or violate its Code of Conduct (*even if* the behavior or suspected behavior does not rise to the level of "known or suspected child abuse or neglect" under Connecticut law, and *even if* the member, staff, or volunteer is not a Mandatory Reporter under Connecticut law). This internal report should be made to the local superior or, if the superior himself is the subject of concern, to the Institute's provincial superior in Chicago.

TO THE EXTENT ALLOWED BY LAW, all reporting will be kept in strict confidence, so as to protect the rights of the one who reports the concern, the potential victim, and the potential accused.

If the incident was reported to Connecticut civil authorities, attach Form DCF-136 to this form. If the incident was *not required to be reported* to Connecticut civil authorities, complete the form on the back of this page.
