Missouri law asks ALL individuals to report suspicions of child abuse and neglect IMMEDIATELY, at the Hotline, which operates 24 hours per day, 365 days per year:

Mandatory Reporters under Missouri Law are REQUIRED to report suspicions of child abuse and neglect at the Hotline above, or the report can be made online (if a non-emergency), using this site. <a href="https://apps.dss.mo.gov/OnlineCanReporting/default.aspx">https://apps.dss.mo.gov/OnlineCanReporting/default.aspx</a>. The Archdiocese of St. Louis requires that any Mandated Reporter who makes a report to the state of Missouri also inform the Diocesan General Counsel of that report, which shall be kept confidential. Please contact the General Counsel at tombuckley@archstl.org or (314) 792-7076.

The Diocese of Kansas City-St. Joseph requires that any Mandated Reporter who has reasonable cause to suspect child abuse or neglect of a minor also make a report to the Diocesan Ombudsman at (816) 812-2500, if the report involves a Diocesan employee, cleric, or volunteer.

In addition, the Institute's Code of Conduct requires *all* members, staff and volunteers to report *all* behaviors that raise concerns or violate its Code of Conduct (*even if* the behavior or suspected behavior does not rise to the level of "suspected child abuse or neglect" under Missouri law, and *even if* the member, staff, or volunteer is not a Mandatory Reporter under Missouri law). This internal report should be made to the local superior or, if the superior himself is the subject of concern, to the Institute's provincial superior in Chicago.

TO THE EXTENT ALLOWED BY LAW, all reporting will be kept in strict confidence, so as to protect the rights of the one who reports the concern, the potential victim, and the potential accused.
